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CEP is conscious of the need among general faculty for occasional guidance and support when confronted with the often sensitive decisions surrounding cases of academic dishonesty. In recognition of this need, Committee on Committees has been asked to create the Faculty Advisory Panel on Academic Integrity (FAPAI).

CEP envisions that faculty serving on FAPAI will provide a critically important service to their faculty colleagues. FAPAI members will be charged to be available, in an advisory capacity only, to faculty instructors who wish to ask general questions regarding academic dishonesty and/or the formal campus procedures detailed in the UCSD Policy on Integrity of Scholarship; and specific questions relating to individual cases that the faculty instructor seeking advice may be involved in.

CEP expectation is that faculty will feel comfortable asking their colleagues advice regarding incidents of academic dishonesty. FAPAI members will offer feedback on personal experiences regarding, for example, how to prevent cheating in particular situations, how to structure information on one's course syllabus and examination booklets such that students are fully aware of the campus policy, what constitutes cheating in a particular situation, when to proceed with a formal charge, whether the evidence they have collected is adequate for a hearing, how to prepare for a hearing, and any other questions which may arise.
