SUBJECT: Enrollment Management Pilot - Capacity-Based Admissions Management Report

Dear Colleagues:

In the fall of 2013, a Capacity-Based Admissions Management Workgroup was charged with recommending an admissions-based method to manage the distribution of students, so that the preferred majors of incoming students could be closely matched to available student openings in each department without necessitating the use of impacted status. In the Fall of 2014, Senate Council approved a three-year enrollment management pilot program. The pilot has concluded, and a report from the Dean of Undergraduate Education has been submitted for Senate review, with the recommendation that the program be made permanent.
