UC Vice Provost Susan Carlson has submitted a proposed new Academic Personnel Manual section for Senate review, APM 11 – Academic Freedom, Protection of Professional Standards, and Responsibilities of Non-Faculty Academic Appointments. The proposal was developed by the Working Group on Privileges and Responsibilities of Non-Faculty Academic Appointees, charged with developing recommendations.

The attachment contains the review materials, which include a cover letter from Vice Provost Carlson, a letter from the co-chairs of the Working Group, the draft policy, and a FAQ. Each document is bookmarked.


