- Department of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering proposal to change the name of the Master of Advanced Studies (MAS) in Architecture-based Enterprise Systems Engineering to MAS in Convergent Systems Engineering with a specialization in Architecture-based Enterprise Systems and establish MAS degrees in Convergent Systems Engineering with a specialization in Cyber-Physical Social Systems and Convergent Systems Engineering with a specialization in Value Supply Chains
- Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry proposal to add four specializations to the PhD in Biochemistry and Molecular Biophysics: Computational Science, Multiscale Biology, Quantitative Biology, and Interdisciplinary Environmental Research
