Due to the length of the June 4, 2024 Representative Assembly agenda and the importance of the items under consideration, two special Representative Assembly meetings are being scheduled to continue discussion of items on the published June 4, 2024 meeting agenda. As noted in the call for the June 4 meeting, the agenda includes six proposals related to Chancellor Pradeep K. Khosla's actions regarding use of outside police to remove the encampment of protesters.
