# Memorial Text

## Adjunct Faculty Series Academic Senate Membership Memorial to the Regents

The U.C. Academic Senate petitions the University of California Board of Regents to amend Standing Order 105.1.a to add to the Academic Senate each person giving instruction in any curriculum under the control of the Academic Senate whose academic title is ... Assistant Adjunct Professor appointed at more than 50% time; Associate Adjunct Professor appointed at more than 50% time; and Adjunct Professor appointed at more than 50% time.

## Health Sciences Clinical Faculty Series Academic Senate Membership Memorial to the Regents

The U.C. Academic Senate petitions the University of California Board of Regents to amend Standing Order 105.1.a to add to the Academic Senate each person giving instruction in any curriculum under the control of the Academic Senate whose academic title is Health Sciences Assistant Clinical Professor appointed at more than 50% time; Health Sciences Associate Clinical Professor appointed at more than 50% time; and Health Sciences Clinical Professor appointed at more than 50% time.

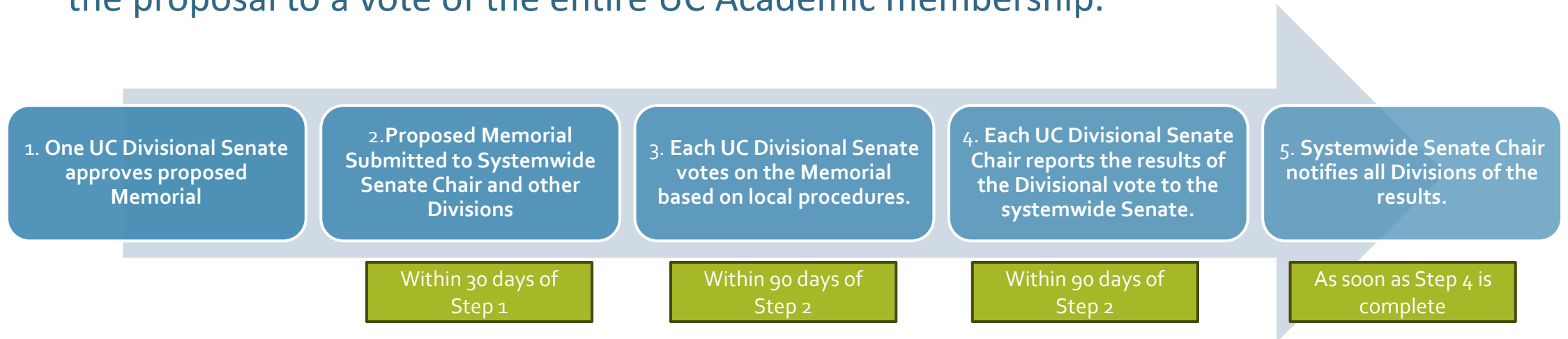

# Overview: Memorials Process (Senate Bylaw 90)

## Part I. Divisional Senate Consideration

- Memorials to the Regents initiated by one Division of the UC Academic Senate are first considered by the other nine UC Divisional Senates to determine whether to advance the proposal to a vote of the entire UC Academic membership.



### OUTCOME OF PART I.

If at least 3 Divisions representing at least 35% of the entire UC Academic Senate membership approve, the proposed Memorials proceed to Part II (a vote of the entire UC membership). If the number of approvals does not satisfy this requirement, the proposed Memorial is disapproved, and no further action can be taken.

# Overview: Memorials Process (Senate Bylaw 90)

## Key Dates for San Diego Divisional Consideration

- **January 17, 2025:** Divisional Chair notification to Senate faculty.
- **January 24 & 30, 2025:** Town Halls to discuss Memorials.
- **February 18, 2025:** Representative Assembly vote.
- **March 18, 2025:** Due date to report San Diego Senate outcome.

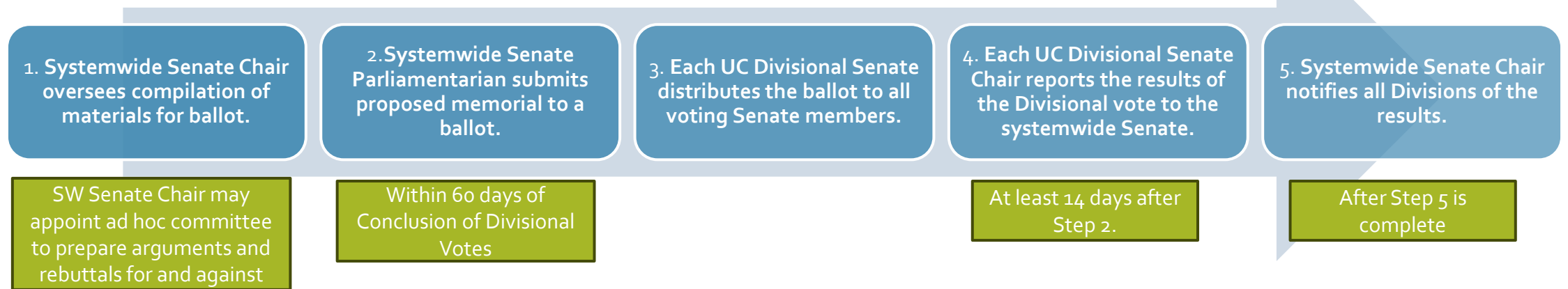
## Vote Options (per Senate Bylaw 90)

- **Approve**
- **Disapprove**
- **Decline to Act** (*a vote cast without judgment on the merits of the memorial*)

# Overview: Memorials Process (Senate Bylaw 90)

## Part II. Consideration by Entire UC Academic Senate Membership

- Memorials to the Regents approved in accordance with the previous slide are submitted to a ballot of all voting members of the UC Academic Senate.



### OUTCOME OF PART II.

A Memorial that has received a majority of the valid ballots cast is sent by the Systemwide Senate Chair to the UC President for submission to the Regents.

# Summary of UCSF Memorials Materials

## History

- **April 18, 2024:** San Francisco Divisional Senate considered the 2 Memorials at annual Division meeting.
- **October 25, 2024:** San Francisco Divisional Senate Executive Council approved the language of the 2 Memorials.
- **November 4-18, 2024:** Electronic vote of Senate and non-Senate faculty to approve the 2 Memorials.

# Summary of UCSF Memorials Materials

## Outcome

### Adjunct Faculty Series Academic Senate Membership Memorial to the Regents

#### Senate Faculty (69% in favor)

- For: 287
- Against: 129
- Abstain: 12

#### Senate & Non-Senate Faculty (79.8% in favor)

- For: 585
- Against: 148
- Abstain: 32

### Health Sciences Clinical Faculty Series Academic Senate Membership Memorial to the Regents

#### Senate Faculty (70.5% in favor)

- For: 296
- Against: 124
- Abstain: 9

#### Senate & Non-Senate Faculty (82.5% in favor)

- For: 623
- Against: 132
- Abstain: 11
